## STUDENT FEES, FINES AND CHARGES

The purpose of a student fees policy is to establish which costs for activities and projects may reasonably be charged to students and which costs will be financed with district funds.

## The school board believes that:

- a. The district should provide a variety of activities and projects for all students. All students should be encouraged to participate in such activities and projects.
- b. Costs of required activities and projects should be financed with district funds.
- c. Costs for non-required activities and projects may reasonably be assessed to students.
- d. Total costs assessed to an individual student for non-required activities and projects during each school year should not be excessive.

The following guidelines should be used for implementing the above policy:

- a. Student fees may not be assessed for direct costs of participation in required activities and projects.
- b. Students may be charged for district-owned property which they lose or damage.
- c. Student fees may be assessed for non-required activities. If such activities occur during a regular school day, an alternative activity with similar educational objectives will be provided without cost to students who do not participate in the activity for which a fee is being charged.
- d. Students may be charged, in part or in total, for materials used for projects which, on a predetermined basis, result in products which become the student's property.
- e. The district will reasonably and discreetly provide funds, in part or in total, to those students who are unable to assume the costs of student-assessed fees.
- f. Total fees assessed for student activities and projects will be monitored by grade level.
